A Feudo Arancio Colour: Concentrated red with purple reflections. Bouquet: Intense aromas of blackberry, raspberry, and cranberry with hints of liquorice, plum and vanilla. Flavour: Refined wine of great depth; restrained use of oak adds a layer of complexity to this structured wine.

Pairings: it pairs well with meat sauce, grilled meats, game and aged cheese; it also pairs well with grilled fish and tuna or swordfish steaks.
